TIME - Volunteer Opportunities

- Lead a workshop, program, or other opportunity for library patrons.
- Support senior wellness programs by greeting participants, assisting with sign-in, and helping with safe room setup.
- Assist Friends of the Library with fundraisers, donor mailings, book sales, open houses, and community outreach.
